

NOTICE OF CANCELLATION – Section 64 of the *Insurers Act* for Quebec residents

As stated in the *Insurers Act*, you have 10 days from when you receive the insurer’s letter of approval to cancel your enrollment in your group insurance plan’s optional benefits and **get a full premium refund**. To cancel your optional benefits, you must complete and return this form to the insurer by the previously mentioned deadline.

Your premiums will be refunded either by the group insurance policyholder (for example, your employer, your association or your union) or, in some cases, by the insurer.

After the deadline, you may end your optional benefits at any time by contacting the policyholder, but no premiums will be refunded for the period prior to your request.
